I was in Liberia from December 3, 2010 - March 23, 2011. It was a great time as I was reunited with so many friends...those from Liberia and from the ship who now live in Liberia. I was also very blessed to make some new friends. I am very thankful for friends....it would be so lonely without them! I am home for a short time but will be returning to Liberia in six months for a long term stay.

I shared about Camp Hope, the youth camp we held the beginning of January 2011 in a previous e-mail, but I wanted to say thanks again for all the prayers during this time. There are many young people who are now serving the Lord and walking in the freedom that comes from Christ as a result of their time at Camp Hope. I was not able to send photos while I was in Liberia due to the slow internet connection, so I have added a few to this newsletter. I hope you enjoy!

I am happy to report that Master's Design has started Children's Ministry and is now working with churches in three communities in Monrovia. Most churches in Liberia do not have any sort of children's ministry. The churches are quite small and therefore the children are not allowed to participate in the service. They are seated at the back of the church and made to sit during the entire service so they don't 'get in the way'. I had a great time during the workshops with the Pastor's as I taught on God's Heart Toward Children. The Lord began to open their eyes to see that there is not a 'Jr. Holy Spirit', there is just as much 'power' in a child's prayer as there is in an adult's prayer and children need to be able to worship the Lord in their own way. I have attached one of the updates I received a week ago from Pastor Washington, the pastor that is helping me with the children's ministry in Liberia. I hope it encourages you as much as it did me!

I am also praising the Lord for what He is doing in Community 21. Pastor Miango, the Pastor I was working with in this community, said the community had never seen churches come together in unity. After praying about this I felt the Lord was leading me to show one of the Transformation videos. There were five churches invited to watch the video and the Lord began to touch their hearts and now every Saturday 6-10 churches meet for two hours to pray together to see transformation come to their community.

Thanks so much for your prayers and support. You have been part of all that the Lord is doing in Liberia. I pray the Lord will bless you as you continue to pray and support Master's Design. Thanks for being so faithful!!!
